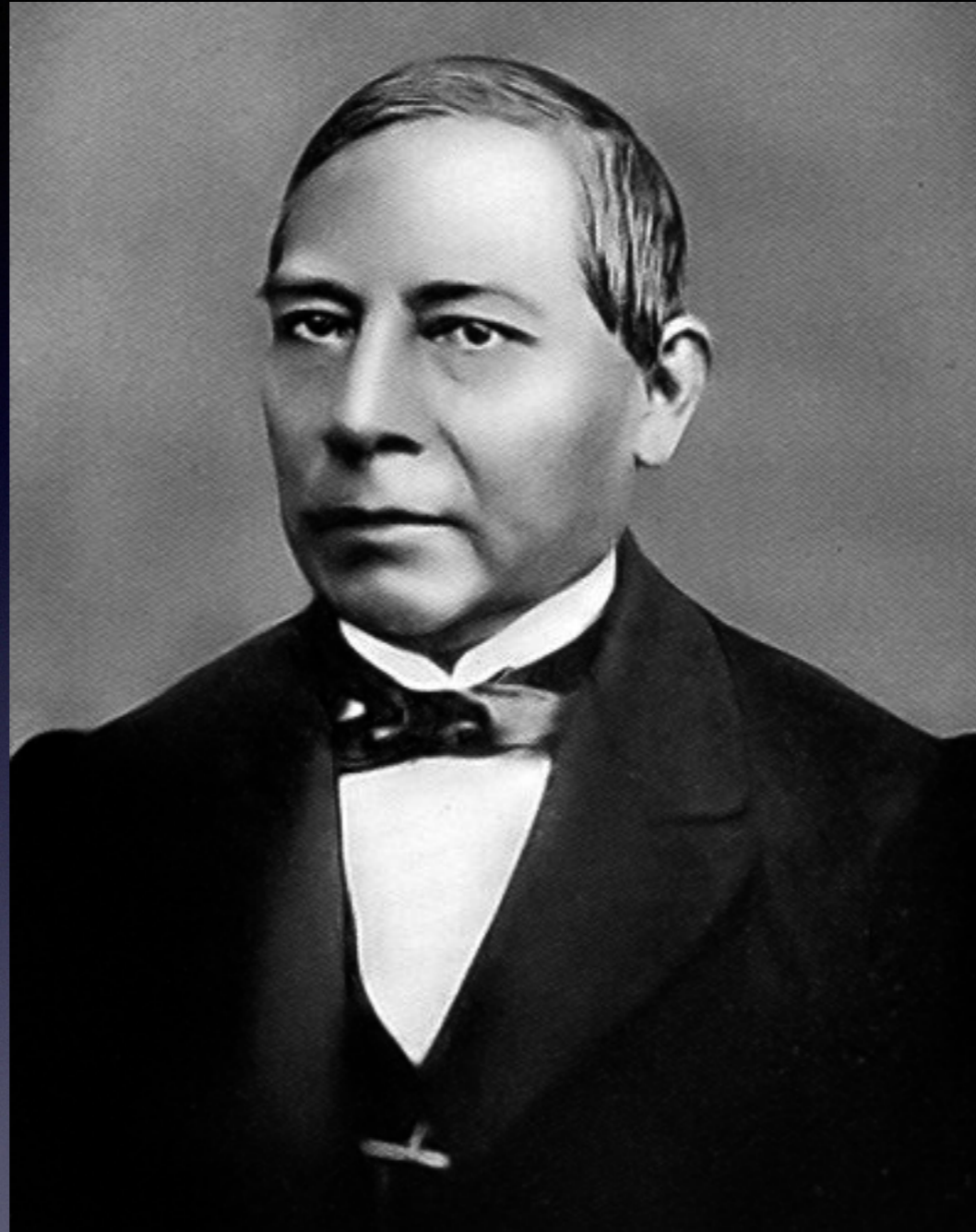

Early Life

- Benito Pablo Juárez García
- Born March 21, 1806 in San Pablo Guelatao, Oaxaca, Mexico
- Lost both his parents at the age of three years old



Benito's Career

- He originally was studying to become a priest
- In 1829 he then entered the Oaxaca Institute of Arts and Science where he then studied law
- He received his law degree and obtain a seat in the Municipal council in 1843

- Benito Juárez refused to accept the rule of Monarchy or any foreign nations
- He promoted equal rights to the Indian population
- Wanted to take the power the Roman Catholic Church had over the political and financial power

- Benito Juárez was exiled along with other liberals in 1853
- 1855 he returned after the liberals won the election
- In 1861 Benito Juárez became president of Mexico
